Title:	Semi-extraspecial Groups
Speaker:	Dr. Mark Lewis, Department of Mathematics, Kent State University

Abstract:

Extraspecial groups play an important role in group theory, particularly in problems involving character degrees. We will show how extraspecial groups can be generalized to semi-extraspecial groups. We will present some of the the basic results regarding semi-extraspecial groups. Then we focus on semi-extraspecial groups that have an abelian subgroup of maximal possible order and consider a connection with semifields.
